Program Learning Outcomes

- PLO1: Students will participate in the nursing process to provide safe client-centered care as measured by 85% of students will answer correlated final exam questions correctly, 95% of students will provide several satisfactory examples throughout the semester on the Clinical Evaluation Tool as verified by clinical instructor, 85% of the students will exceed national mean on the safety and infection control sections of the ATI Proctored Exam Comprehensive Predictor.
- PLO2: Students will participate in providing evidence-based care from an established plan of care by the RN as measured by 85% of students will answer correlated final exam questions correctly, 85% of the students will exceed national mean on the Evidence Based Practice portion of the ATI Comprehensive Predictor.
