PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

This is a 204-hour lecture and laboratory course, which includes information necessary to successfully pass the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Board Examination (PTCE). Topics include: Federal laws/regulations, conversion/calculations, dosage forms and routes of administration, drug information, classification of drugs, medication safety/error, prescription processing, over the counter (OTC) medications, hospital pharmacy, repackaging/compounding, aseptic technique, pharmacy stock/billing, body system review, anatomy/physiology/pathophysiology, microbiology & chemistry.
