This is a 112-hour course which leads to National Certification. Lecture & Laboratory to include cardiovascular anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology, EKG language, cardiac rhythm and sinus rules, atrial rhythms, junctional rhythms, ventricular rhythms, AV blocks, tachycardia, bradycardia, PVC, pacemakers, timing, cardiac stress testing, holter monitoring, operating and EKG machine, and certification examination.
