NURSE AIDE I

This is a 192-hour State Approved lecture, laboratory, and clinical course, which leads to State Certification as a CNA I. 46 Skills will be demonstrated by State Approved Nurse Aide Instructors and must be validated by student. Introduction to health care, anatomy-physiology-pathophysiology, personal care skills, interpersonal communication skills, HIPPA, safety, and death & dying, infection control, legal ethics, professionalism, the health care system, patient safety, basic first aid, acute care, and home care environment. Pre-requisite: Career Focus with Work-keys Assessment.

After successful completion of the 192-hour course, graduates are eligible to take the NC State certification examination: Fee \$140 and students to perform skills proficiency evaluations.

To Register Must Provide

- Original Driver's License, State Issued Identification Card, or Passport
- Social Security Card - must be signed and not laminated
- Names must match on ALL documents
- Attend 7-hour Career Focus class with Work Keys Assessment Score

Health Records/Background Check

Must be turned in to Instructor within the first two weeks of class. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Clinicals are required. All of our clinical partners require COVID vaccination. Please upload proof of vaccination or medical/religious waiver to Castlebranch within the first two weeks of class.
- Background Check & Drug Screen done through Castle Branch (See information sheet to enter system to collect records)
- Physical Exam & Health History within the past year
- Hepatitis B Vaccine (1st & 2nd dose) Hepatitis Booster or 3rd dose due 6 months from 1st injection
- Tetanus (must be T-DAP) within 10 years
- TB two step Skin Test annually 1st one initial dose, then wait one week and repeat TB test
- MMR (2 doses) - only one dose is needed if born before 1957
- Varicella Titer (only if you HAVE HAD the chicken pox) otherwise must have Varicella vaccine
- Two doses of Varicella Vaccine (if you HAVE NOT had the chicken pox)
- Flu Vaccine if registering for a class that takes place between October through April
- COVID-19 Vaccine is optional
