How much does it cost to attend BIP?

Attending BIP is free of charge, except for transportation fees, to cover the cost of utilizing the Brunswick Transit System. The BCC Board of Trustees decides on a flat fee rate, which is currently \$65.00 per month.

Does BIP provide transportation? Yes. The Brunswick Transit System (BTS) provides transportation. The BCC Board of Trustees decides on a flat fee rate, currently \$65.00 per month. You can also provide transportation. Our program runs Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 3 PM, year-round.
