Program Learning Outcomes

PLO1: (Humanities/Fine Arts) College Transfer program students will demonstrate a readiness for Junior/Senior-level communication skills by expressing thoughtful content clearly and logically written in standard American English or by giving prepared, purposeful presentations, designed to increase knowledge, to foster understanding, or to promote change in the listeners' attitudes, values, beliefs, or behaviors. Students will show the ability to integrate an understanding of cultures including artistic expression, philosophical thought, or religious value systems into their communications.

PLO2: (Quantitative/Scientific Literacy and Reasoning) College Transfer program students will demonstrate a readiness for transfer to a senior institution by applying quantitative reasoning and scientific literacy skills include the ability to reason and solve quantitative problems using such elements as words, tables, graphs, and equations, and to articulating scientific knowledge of fundamental concepts and scientific inquiry methodologies with analysis, providing the capacity to make reasoned and ethical judgements about regional and global impact of math and science on the individual, society and environment.

PLO3: (Social Sciences) College Transfer program students will demonstrate a readiness for transfer to a senior institution by understanding the social behavioral sciences including individual behaviors and the impact of larger socio-economic and historical forces on individuals.
