

## Agreement Information

### (Between BCC and Four-Year Colleges/Universities)

**Appalachian State University** (June 2024)- The Aspire Appalachian Pathway Program ensures guaranteed admission to Appalachian State University (App State) after completing an eligible associate degree at BCC with a 2.25 GPA or higher, which includes the Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), Associate in Arts in Teacher Preparation (AATP), Associate in Science in Teacher Preparation (ASTP), or the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) through an institutional or state-wide articulation agreement. BCC students will be assigned advisors from BCC and App State while attending BCC, to ensure proper courses are selected. BCC students will also have early access to financial aid advising and planning with App State, plus early registration for App State classes and priority consideration for the Appalachian Excellence Scholarship. Students must apply while at BCC through the Aspire Appalachian intent form (BCC will assist with this). Once submitted, you will be contacted by your transfer admissions counselor from App State while at BCC.

**Barton College** (June 2010) – Will accept 64 credits from AAS Early Childhood Associate program towards Birth to Kindergarten with Teacher Certification (B-K) Transfer Program

**Campbell University** (January 2012)-Campbell-BCC Transfer Opportunity Program (TOP)-Campbell University will accept appropriate transfer hours up to 64 credits from AAS programs and guarantee admission into Campbell’s Bachelor of Applied Science degree program.

**Campbell University** (August 2024)- Campbell Assured Admission Program - The program will allow currently enrolled BCC students an assured-entry pathway to Campbell University. The Program affords BCC students information about academic programs, and access to faculty and staff at the Campbell University campus who will facilitate their transition to Campbell University. This Program prioritizes the ability to receive admission, financial aid, and orientation communications early in the transition process, which sets BCC students up for maximum success at both institutions. Limited access to Campbell University activities, services, and facilities occurs at the point of acceptance, commitment, and enrollment in the Program. Full access to Campbell University activities, services, and facilities begins upon matriculation at Campbell University. The Program requires completion of the Associate’s degree from Brunswick Community College in a college transfer program (Associate in Arts or Associate in Science) or an articulated applied program for guaranteed university admission.

**East Carolina University** (August 2019) ECU and BCC enter into a co-admission agreement designed to improve transfer students access and success through a collaborative baccalaureate degree completion program. Students must be enrolled in an Early College, Career and College Promise program or be in their first year of community college enrollment prior to applying for Pirate Promise. Submit a completed Pirate Promise application. Commit to a full-time status. Students must complete the degree requirements at BCC for an AA, AS, AE or and AAS in Early Childhood Education. **Fayetteville State University (FSU)** (June 2019) \$10,000 Degree Pathway. FSU and BCC conveys the parties’ mutual intention to partner together to offer online degree programs to North Carolina residents enrolled in BCC for a maximum “out-of-pocket” cost of \$10,000 (\$10k Pathway Plan). Current

FSU online programs are: Accounting, Birth to Kindergarten (non-teaching), Criminal Justice, Fire and Emergency Services Administration, Business Administration (General), Intelligence Studies, Nursing, Professional Studies, Psychology, and Sociology. **Lees McRae College** (Sept 2018) BCC students who earn an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree in Criminal Justice Technology and who seek to complete their bachelor of Arts and Applied Science (B.A.A.S.) Degree through the LMC Criminal Justice Program, will be registered as a Junior class status at LMC, shall have academic credits earned at BCC of a C and above accepted at face value, LMC will only accept a total of 12 credits hours for grades of D, BCC students will enter LMC with at least 68 semester hours of credit.

**Lees McRae College** (Sept 2017) BCC students who earn an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree in Business Administration and who seek to complete their bachelor of Arts and Applied Science (B.A.A.S.) Degree through the LMC Business Administration Program, will be registered as a Junior class status at LMC, shall have academic credits earned at BCC of a C and above accepted at face value, LMC will only accept a total of 12 credits hours for grades of D, BCC students will enter LMC with at least 71 semester hours of credit.

**North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University** (October 2020) join in a collaborative effort to facilitate the transfer of students from BCC with an Associate in Applied Science in Turfgrass Management Technology into the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education (Secondary Education) Program at N.C. A&T with certain terms and conditions found in the agreement.

**North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University** (October 2020) join in a collaborative effort to facilitate the transfer of students from BCC with an Associate in Applied Science in Turfgrass Management Technology into the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education (Agricultural Professional Service) Program at N.C. A&T with certain terms and conditions found in the agreement.

**North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University** (October 2020) join in a collaborative effort to facilitate the transfer of students from BCC with an Associate in Applied Science in Horticulture Technology into the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education (Secondary Education) Program at N.C. A&T with certain terms and conditions found in the agreement.

**North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University** (October 2020) join in a collaborative effort to facilitate the transfer of students from BCC with an Associate in Applied Science in Horticulture Technology into the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education (Agricultural Professional Service) Program at N.C. A&T with certain terms and conditions found in the agreement.

**North Carolina Central University** (February 2004) Will accept 64 credits from Early Childhood Education towards North Carolina Teaching License in the area of Birth to Kindergarten.

**North Carolina State University** – (December 2020) has a MOU with Brunswick Community College for Students admitted into the NC State C3 Programs and who are enrolled in Brunswick Community College, and for BCC graduates with the AA, AS, AE, AATP or ASTP degree. See specific terms and conditions found in this agreement.

**North Carolina Wesleyan (2018)** agrees to grant any student who is the recipient of a Criminal Justice associate degree from Brunswick Community College, sixty hours towards the baccalaureate degree and junior standing.

**North Carolina Wesleyan (2021)** has a MOU with Brunswick Community College that enhances and expands the educational opportunities of Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), and Associate in Applied Science (AAS) graduates by offering BCC graduates access to the benefits of the Wesleyan Works program, pre-admission advising, generous transfer credit, and a clear definition of the transfer of courses from BCC to NCWC. See more specific terms and conditions found in the agreement.

**Regis University (September 2006)**-Memorandum of Understanding between Regis University Associate's to Bachelor's Program and Brunswick Community College.

**Salem International University (Nov. 2016)** Students who earn an Associate of Arts, Science or Applied Science from BCC, will enter as a junior. (Other criteria apply, see agreement)

**Seminole State College Florida (November 2021)** Beginning Fall 2022, students who have completed the Associate in Applied Science Degree in Information Systems (64 credits) at Brunswick Community College will receive articulated college credit at Seminole State College of 48 credits (see agreement for details). This agreement renews automatically yearly up to five years (fall 2027). The agreement will need to be re-executed.

**University of Mount Olive (June 2015)** Provide current students and recent graduates guaranteed admission and acceptance of appropriate transfer hours, up to 64 credits from specified AAS programs with a minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. BCC AAS graduates will receive up to 64 hours of credit for completed courses. These credit hours will include a combination of hours of general education credit, hours of elective credit, or hours of credit toward the major as evaluated by appropriate UMO division/departmental advisors and the UMO Registrar's Office.

**University of Mount Olive (October 2019)** This agreement is to define how UMO will offer its courses at a reduced tuition rate to Brunswick Community College employees and former students and how Brunswick community College will provide opportunities to UMO to promote and recruit their employees and former students.

**University of North Carolina at Greensboro (July 2017)** will allow graduates of the Early Childhood Education (A55220) program to earn a Bachelor's Degree. (Other criteria apply, see agreement)

**University of North Carolina at Pembroke (February 2012, revised January 2019)** this agreement is between UNCP and BCC for students who complete the required hours for the AAS degree in Criminal Justice Technology from BCC and transfer to UNCP and major in Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice.

**University of North Carolina at Pembroke (December 2012)** Will accept 62 credits, including general education and pre-requisite courses. In addition, 30 additional nursing credits related to the Associate Degree, will be transferred after completion of two validation courses at UNCP (NUR 3000 and NUR 3200).

**University of North Carolina at Pembroke (January 2015, revised October 2017, December 2023)** have an articulation agreement allowing students who complete an A.A. S. in Health and Fitness Science Technology to transfer to UNCP and major in Bachelor of Science in Exercise and Sport Science (Health Promotion Track or Exercise Physiology Track, added Fitness Specialist Track in 2023).

**University of North Carolina at Pembroke** (March 2015, revised for 2016-2017) agrees to provide onsite services to support BCC military-affiliated students.

**University of North Carolina at Wilmington** (December 2022) has a MOU with Brunswick Community College with the Community College Undergraduate Research Experience program (CCURE). (See agreement for criteria and other information)

**University of North Carolina at Wilmington** (January 2018) UNCW agrees to accept college transfer coursework completed at BCC for students who complete the AAS degree in Health and Fitness Science. (Other criteria apply, see agreement)

**University of North Carolina at Wilmington** (June 2009, revised 2015, revised April 2019) this is a pathway for guaranteed admission to UNCW for students completing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree or Associate of Engineering with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) in transferable, college-level coursework from BCC.

**University of North Carolina at Wilmington** (March 2006) have an articulation agreement allowing students who complete an A.A.S. in Early Childhood Education to transfer to UNCW into the Education of Young Children program leading to a Bachelor of Arts degree.

University of North Carolina at Wilmington (September 2023) as a commitment to creating access opportunities and establishing meaningful transfer partnerships, UNCW is establishing Path Ways. This program provides guaranteed access for students transferring between UNCW and the North Carolina Community College System. It is a pathway for guaranteed transfer admission to UNCW for students completing an AA, AS, AE, AATP, ASTP, OR AFA from a North Carolina Community College. See agreement for more detailed requirements.

**Western Governors University** (March 2019) all transferrable courses that are completed at BCC with a letter of "C" or higher are accepted and applied toward the appropriate college degree (with exception of licensure programs or state requirements were a grade of "B" or better may be required). Credits from transferrable courses completed with a letter grade of "C-" or lower will not transfer.

**Western Governors University** (June 2023) this agreement is to provide BCC graduates and employees with flexible, personalized learning pathways to higher education and professional development (degrees, certificates, and credentials) through WGU's innovative online university and applicable WGU affiliates.
