ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS BETWEEN BCC AND 4-YEAR COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES

Articulation Agreements

The North Carolina **Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA)** and **Independent Comprehensive Articulation Agreements (ICAA)** outlines the process for admitting community college graduates to UNC institutions and transferring credits between colleges within the NC Community College System and institutions within The University of North Carolina. These agreements provide key guarantees for transferring students, including:

- Guaranteed admission to one of the 16 UNC institutions (Transfer Assured Admissions Policy)
- The ability for NC community college graduates with an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree to transfer to a UNC institution with junior status
