Comments:

In every instance in which a state is checked yes, the candidate will need to complete an application and any required testing. The “yes” designation confirms that this state will not require additional training because the number of hours at Brunswick CC meets or exceeds the state’s standard.

Alabama – Allows for limited transfer and employment to certain long term care facilities. All other positions and employment locations require enrollment in one of Alabama’s approved training programs. This state is marked undetermined because the acceptance of the NC credential is dependent on where the candidate intends to work.

Indiana – This state will accept training that occurred in NC; however, the state requires examination within first twenty days of employment.

Maine - Requires 32 hours of paid experience per week for three years.

Minnesota - Prior paid work experience is required.

Missouri – Only 175 of training is required in this state; however, prior paid work experience is required.

Oregon- 400 hours of paid employment in two year period.

Rhode Island - 100 hours of education, active certification, and full time employment for three months.

Tennessee – CNA's from NC must enroll in an approved Tennessee training program .

Vermont – 400 hours of employment is required
