Student Spotlight: Meet Mark Williams



Brunswick Community College (BCC) Student Ambassador Mark Williams, Jr. knows firsthand the value of perseverance.

Now, in his second year as a computer science student, Mark is on track to earn his associate degree in December—a major milestone. For the first time in years, he, his wife Raquel (pictured above with Mark), and their two children feel they are exactly where they should be, working hard and embracing new opportunities.

Originally from Pittsburgh, PA, he graduated high school with plans to follow in his father's footsteps at Clarion University as a Division I wrestler. However, academic struggles put that on a temporary hold. Instead, he started at a local community college before transferring to Clarion—only to realize it wasn't the right fit. Looking for a fresh start, Mark enlisted in the United States Navy.

After the military, Mark cycled through various jobs, struggling to find his niche. Then, he and his wife took a leap of faith, relocating to Sunset Beach, NC—an area he had visited as a child. Mark explored real estate and law enforcement but switched gears when an opportunity in the Computer Science field arose. "I wanted a career that I genuinely enjoyed and was good at while also providing for my family," Mark shared. "That meant returning to school, and I knew it wouldn't be easy. But choosing BCC has made all the difference."

At age 35, Mark enrolled in BCC's Computer Science program and immediately felt at home. "From day one, everyone here was welcoming, always asking how they could help me succeed," he said. "That level of support was something I wasn't used to—and it has been life-changing."

Mark learned about BCC's Student Ambassador program during the admissions process and decided to apply. He was selected, and it has become one of the most rewarding experiences of his journey. "Being an ambassador is one of the best things I've ever done. I love representing this school, meeting incredible people, and staying motivated," he said. "It keeps me on track because I know people are rooting for me—and I won't let them down."

Education is now a family affair for the Williamses. Their children are thriving, and they even compare grades! Meanwhile, Raquel will begin at BCC this fall. "No other place could provide her with better opportunities," said Mark. "The instructors, leadership, and staff truly care about students—it doesn't get any better."

As he prepares for graduation, Mark is eager to enter the computer science field and wants to continue his education. His journey has had its share of twists and turns, but he hopes his story inspires others.

"No matter what, never give up," he said. "Get rid of the self-doubt, take the leap, figure out what makes you tick, and come to BCC. You are bound to succeed." Congratulations Mark!
