

MEDICATION AIDE

CONTINUING EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

This is a 26-hour course which leads to State Certification as a Medication Aide.

To Register, Must Provide

- Unexpired driver's license, state-issued identification card, or passport
- Social security card
- Must be a Certified Nursing Assistant and currently listed on the North Carolina Nurse Aide Registry and provide printed copy

Topics

This course prepares the student to be able to assume that role and responsibilities of the Medication Aide. The course includes information the Medication Aide will need to understand and perform basic competencies required to safely administer medications by the following routes: oral, buccal (between the cheek and teeth), sublingual (under the tongue), otic (ear), ophthalmic (eye), nasal (nose), topical (on the skin), inhalant (breathed into the lungs), vaginal, and rectal.

Required for Class

- Medication Administration: A Medication Aide Training Course, Student Manual
- Uniform (from current work setting) or scrub bottoms and scrub top
- Shoes to match uniform (white or black)
- Pen, highlighter

Total Cost: \$150
