

NURSE AIDE I

CAREER AND COLLEGE PROMISE (CCP)

This a 192-hour State Approved Course which leads to State Certification as a CNA I.

To Register, Must Provide

- Unexpired driver's license, state-issued identification card, or passport
- Social security card
- Career and College Promise Program authorization form
- Continuing Education registration form
- Immunization record provided by the school RN
- Healthcare Career Focus completion with certificate

Health Records/Background Check

Must be turned in to instructor within the first two weeks of class. Any needed immunizations can be done at Brunswick County Health Department.

- Create a Castle Branch account
- Background check and drug screen done through Castle Branch.
- Physical exam & health history within the past year
- Hepatitis B vaccine (optional)
- Tetanus (must be T-DAP) within 10 years
- TB two-step skin test or QuaniFERON Gold blood test
- MMR (2 doses)
- Varicella vaccine (2 doses)
- Flu vaccine if registering for a class that takes place between October through April.
- COVID-19 vaccine (optional)

Topics

Lecture, Laboratory & Clinical. Introduction to health care, anatomy-physiology-pathophysiology, personal care skills, inter personal communication skills, HIPPA, safety, death & dying, special care concerns, infection control, legal ethics, professionalism, the health care system, patient safety, basic first aid, acute care & home care environment.

Required for Class

Books and scrubs may be purchased at the BCC Bookstore.

- Uniform: Teal scrub top and pants (Cherokee brand); teal or white scrub jacket (optional)
- White shoes (no open toe or backs); white socks
- Hartman's Nursing Assistant Care: The Basics textbook & workbook, American Heart Association BLS/CPR (current edition)
- Wrist watch with second hand.
- 3-inch 3-ring binder

Tuition Cost: \$215

Tuition and books are covered by Career and College Promise Program and Brunswick Community College. After successful completion of the 192-hour course, graduates are eligible to take the NC State certification examination. Fee: \$140.00
