

NURSE AIDE I (NA I)

CONTINUING EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

This is a 192-hour State Approved Course which leads to State Certification as an NA I.

To Register, Must Provide

- Unexpired driver's license, state-issued identification card, or passport
- Social security card
- Healthcare Career Focus completion with certificate

Health Records/Background Check

Must be turned in to instructor within the first two weeks of class. Any needed immunizations can be done at Brunswick County Health Department.

- Create a Castle Branch account (there is an additional fee)
- Background check & drug screen done through Castle Branch
- Physical exam & health history within the past year
- Hepatitis B vaccine (optional)
- Tetanus (must be T-DAP) within 10 years
- TB two-step skin test or QuantiFERON Gold blood test
- MMR: 2 doses if born after 1957, one dose if born before 1957
- Varicella Titer (only if you HAVE HAD the chicken pox)
- Two doses of Varicella vaccine (if you HAVE NOT had chicken pox)
- Flu vaccine if registering for a class that takes place between October through April
- Covid-19 vaccine (optional)

Lecture, Laboratory & Clinical. Introduction to health care, anatomy-physiology-pathophysiology, personal care skills, inter personal communication skills, HIPPA, safety, death & dying, special care concerns, infection control, legal ethics, professionalism, the health care system, patient safety, basic first aid, acute care & home care environment.

Required for Class
