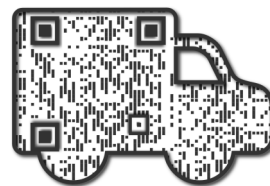

Welcome to the Brunswick Community College EMS Program!

Here are some important items related to our **February 24, 2026** Paramedic Initial course, to be held at between our Main Campus located at 50 College Road NE, Bolivia, NC 28422, and Leland Campus located at 2045 Enterprise Dr NE, Leland, NC 28451. Locations vary by class date.

Registration Steps for Paramedic Didactic One: #51806

-Registration is OPEN-

Step 1- Gather these documents:

1. High School Diploma or GED
2. Proof of college-level Reading and Math levels
 - a. Transcript showing completion of college-level English and Math course, **or**
 - b. Results from a reading comprehension placement test showing college-level Reading and Math, **taken after February 24, 2025**. Bring a copy of the results when you register **and** the first night of class.
Contact The Learning Center at 910-755-7334 for an appointment.
3. Current and valid Advanced-EMT (AEMT) credential (*due by April 22, 2026*). If still working on AEMT, bring your current EMT credential to register for class.
4. If your public safety agency is covering the Insurance and Supply fees, you must have a letter stating that on their *official agency letterhead*. The letter must list the type, and exact fee amounts they are requesting to be billed.

Step 2- Bring the above documents and method of payment (see fee schedule below) to **One-Stop/Admission's Office** located at BCC Main Campus, 50 College Road, Bolivia, NC 28422, on the bottom floor of Building A (main building with the large outside staircase). You will complete the registration form at that time.

Monies due at time of CLINICAL TWO (clinical/field) registration: August 25, 2026

Registration Fee \$180.00 (unless fee exempt under NCCCS waiver)

Step 3- Begin gathering your health records (listed on page 3) and purchase the required textbook package from our bookstore or from the web links located on the last page of this document. You will also need a current completed History & Physical Certification Form from a physician; this form is included in this document. STEP 3 items are **NOT** due at the time of registration.

Other items and fees associated with the class

Textbook Package **\$630-1,100** (varies based on electronic or printed package, and where purchased). See page 3 for ordering weblinks.
Caroline ECS 9e Flipped with Comp - Unit Exams

MyClinicalExchange **\$39.50** - *Due by March 14, 2026 (sooner is better).*

Complio for Clinical **\$142.00** - Includes criminal background check. Any felony convictions or pending misdemeanors are not allowed, except minor traffic violations. Includes drug screening; dates and location will be assigned. *Due March 23, 2026.*

BCC Clinical Polo Shirt **\$33.00** – available for purchase in the BCC Bookstore.

Other uniform requirements that you will need are blue or black EMS-style pant, black boots, black belt. *These are due by April 22, 2026.*

***Health Records** (*due by March 23, 2026*).

- a. Physical screening performed by a physician attesting student is fit for AEMT duties (must use the BCC History & Physical Certification Form, included in this document). A current departmental EMS/FF OSHA physical will also count.
- b. Immunizations/Vaccinations (**DUE by March 20, 2026**). Several of these are childhood immunizations which may be found through your physician, the county health department, or your parent or guardian. If you cannot locate these records,

you can take a simple blood test, called a titer test, which checks for antibodies for many of these required items.

- i. Current Influenza (flu) Vaccination (required October - March)
- ii. Two (2) Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccinations or positive antibody titer
- iii. History of Chicken Pox (documentation required) or two (2) Varicella immunizations
- iv. TB skin test (PPD within the past year) or chest x-ray or TB Screening form. This is a **two-step process**, required two separate TB skin tests performed and read within 7-21 days of each other. TB screening is due every 12-months. Contact your physician or county health department to have this accomplished. A QuantiFERON-TB Gold blood test also meets this requirement.
- v. Tetanus vaccination within the last 10 years (must remain current)
- vi. Three (3) Hepatitis B vaccinations or a signed declination statement.
- vii. Completed COVID-19 series is **not currently** required.

**Cost can vary by medical provider and your personal medical insurance coverage*

NCOEMS Required Anatomy & Physiology Course

This must be completed before October 9, 2025, per NCOEMS requirements.

The required Anatomy and Physiology course shall meet or exceed the requirements listed in the Combined Course Library for the NC Community College System. The Anatomy and Physiology course objectives may be met through a separate course offering or in conjunction with the Paramedic program and incorporated into the lesson plan. Course options that are currently accepted include:

All EMS courses in North Carolina fall under the authority of the state agency NC Office of Emergency Medical Services (NCOEMS). NCOEMS sets the educational requirements for all EMS programs in our state.

Per NCOEMS Rule, students have 90 days from date of completion of the course to make their first attempt at the North Carolina EMS credentialing exam.

"The Brunswick Community College Paramedic program holds a Letter of Review, which is NOT a CAAHEP accreditation status, but is a status granted by the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoAEMSP) signifying that a program seeking initial accreditation has demonstrated sufficient compliance with the accreditation standards through the Letter of Review Self Study Report (LSSR) and other documentation. However, it is NOT a guarantee of eventual accreditation."



HISTORY & PHYSICAL CERTIFICATION FORM FOR EMS STUDENT JOB FUNCTIONS

The North Carolina Community College System and other national standards require that Emergency Medical Services (EMS) students have a History and Physical completed by a Healthcare Provider (HCP) certifying that they are physically and emotionally able to perform the duties of a health professional in providing safe care to patients. In addition, the student is required to provide proof of immunity to certain diseases, and complete screening for tuberculosis. The student has a list of these requirements should he/she require your assistance in completing them.

To the HCP: Please use your office forms to complete the H&P. BCC does not require a form for our files. We only require that this page be completed, stamped, and returned to us. The student has a list of EMS job functions to share with you. Please complete the following:

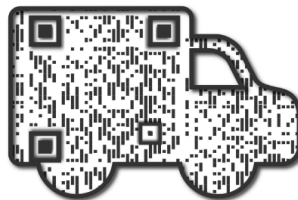
